PARTICIPATION: a strong interaction of policy makers with citizens and civil society was ensured To what extent has citizens and volunteers been involved in implementing the best practice	20
EFFICIENT MANAGEMENT OF RESOURCES: responsible use of internal resources (human, financial or material) and / or diversification of the external ones	10
IMPACT OF THE BEST PRACTICE: the overall effect of the best practice benefits on a larger number of people than the main beneficiaries of a particular institution / community / region, etc.	15
SUSTENAIBILITY of the best practice: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) promotion: the sharing of knowledge and experience of the best practice, as well as its outcomes, will also be considered within other local public authorities / institutions; (2) replication: the possibilities of multiplying the best practice in other communities / by other public institutions / services / organizations; (3) continuity: the local practice tends to be sustainable for future generations to have the benefits of applying this practice long over a significant period of time and to grow in importance. 	20
